2. HOSTEL

2.1 MANAGEMENT OF PROBLEMS

Mr. Sibanda deals with the daily disciplinary problems. If there are serious matters, they will be discussed with Mr Bornman so that he can deal with them.

If your child experiences any problems at the hostel, he/she must report it immediately. The quicker the problem is reported, the quicker it can be resolved. There are 2 men and 1 lady on duty at the hostel every day.

2.2 SMOKING

If you as parents allow the learners to smoke at home, it intensifies the current problem. DA Müller Hostel is a smoke-free area. "Vape" is becoming a large and serious problem in the hostel. Many learners claim that their parents supply them with these "vapes". This is a violation of the Law on Smoking and action will be taken against these learners. As parents, can you please support us in this matter.

2.3 SICK LEARNERS

It is happening more often that sick children arrive at the hostel on a Sunday and Monday. **Please under no circumstances should your child be sent to the hostel on a Sunday if he/she is ill. We will expect you to come and fetch your sick child.**

2.4 MEDICATION

Learners are not allowed to keep their prescribed or any other medicine in their cupboards. It must be handed in at the sick bay. Please make sure that the dosage and frequency is clearly indicated on each container. Also indicate what the medication is prescribed for. Thank you for your co-operation.

2.5 SCHOOL UNIFORM

We request parents to please help and make sure your child returns after a weekend with the correct school uniform. Many children give an excuse that the school shoes and clothes were forgotten at home; then they walk around all week with the wrong clothes. Thank you for your support.

2.6 NELSPRUIT BUS

The services of the Nelspruit bus will end on 22 November 2024. There will be no hostel Nelspruit bus from January 2025. Parents must please make provision for private transport for their child. There is already existing independent transport available.


