1.2 SCHOOL ACCOUNTS

- Parents with outstanding school fees for 2025 who have not yet made a payment arrangement are requested to **urgently contact the Finance Office via email** to arrange payment at finances@jimvantonder.co.za.
- Please note that **all outstanding accounts of 2025 will be handed over to attorneys on 15 February 2026**. If you are under the impression that a payment arrangement is already in place, please contact us via email to confirm that the arrangement is recorded.
- Should you have made payment and find that it has not been allocated to your account, please email **proof of payment**, together with your **child's full details**, to finances@jimvantonder.co.za so that the necessary correction can be made. We frequently find that the **correct account number is not used as the payment reference**, which makes the allocation of payments difficult.
- We have noted that the **school fees account number is frequently used for the payment of bus tickets**. Should you notice that **bus fees reflect on your school fees account**, we kindly request that you inform the Finance Office **via email at finances@jimvantonder.co.za** so that the necessary correction can be made. We further **urgently request** that, going forward, the payment reference be changed to **"Route + Bus"** to ensure that payments are allocated correctly.
- Should you make a **combined payment for school fees and bus fees**, please ensure that an **email is sent to both finances@jimvantonder.co.za and bus@jimvantonder.co.za**, clearly indicating the **breakdown of amounts**, to enable accurate and efficient allocation. Should no such notification be received, **all payments will be allocated to your school fees account by default**.

We would like to thank parents who are up to date with their payments. It is highly appreciated.

2. **HOSTEL**

2.1 **FINANCES 2026**

2.1.1 **ADMINISTRATION FEE**

There is a compulsory R400.00 administration fee payable at the beginning of January 2026. You are still responsible to pay the R400.00 even if you receive a 100% bursary.

- 2.1.2 HOSTEL FEES FOR 2026**
The hostel fees are R2 220.00 per month for 10 months. You must pay the first month's hostel fees at the beginning of January. All hostel fees are payable in advance.
- 2.1.3 OUTSTANDING HOSTEL FEES**
No learner with any outstanding hostel fees or R400.00 administration fees for 2025 will be allowed back in the hostel in 2026.
- 2.2 LOCKS**
Please make sure your child has 2 locks. It remains every child's responsibility to lock his/her cupboard and room.
- 2.3 BURSARY**
Application forms for bursaries are available from the school. Please apply well in advance for a bursary in 2026. Please note that the closing date for the **submission** of applications is 6 February 2026. No late applications will be accepted.
- 2.4 VANDALISM**
There is currently a serious problem regarding vandalism in the hostel. If your child is guilty of vandalism, the costs will be recovered from you as parent. Your child will also be suspended from the hostel for a full month, as detailed in the hostel's Code of Conduct.
Thank you for your cooperation.
- 2.5 SMOKING**
If you as parents allow the learners to smoke at home, it intensifies the current problem. DA Müller Hostel is a smoke-free area. "Vape" is becoming a large and serious problem in the hostel. Many learners claim that their parents supply them with these "vapes". This is a violation of the Law on Smoking and action will be taken against these learners. As parents, can you please support us in this matter.
- 2.6 SCHOOL UNIFORM**
We request parents to please help and make sure your child returns after a weekend with the correct school uniform. Many children give an excuse that the school shoes and clothes were forgotten at home; then they walk around all week with the wrong clothes. Thank you for your support.
- 2.7 ARRIVAL AT HOSTEL ON SUNDAYS**
No learners will be allowed back on Sunday evening after 19h00. Dinner on Sundays is served at 17h00. If learners arrive after 17h00, no dinner will be available for them.
- 2.8 HOSTEL BANK DEPOSITS**
- There are currently quite a few deposits being made with no or incorrect/unknown references. If you make a deposit and the reference is incorrect, we will not be able to allocate the payment to your account and your account will therefore reflect as overdue.
 - References must be your correct account number or your child's full name and surname.
 - No bus fees may be paid into the hostel's account.
