1.3 BUS FEES

2. HOSTEL

2.1 WARM CLOTHES AND BLANKETS

The season is changing and the evenings are getting colder. Please see to it that your child brings the necessary warm clothing and blankets to the hostel. Please mark all items clearly.

2.2 FINANCES 2026

2.2.1 ADMINISTRATION FEES

There is still compulsory R400.00 administration fees outstanding. You are still responsible to pay the R400.00 even if you receive a 100% bursary.

2.2.2 HOSTEL FEES FOR 2026

The hostel fees are R2 220.00 per month for 10 months.

2.2.3 OUTSTANDING HOSTEL FEES

If the R400.00 administration fee for 2026 is outstanding, the learner will not be allowed in the hostel. Learners received accounts today, 29 May. All accounts must be paid up to date in order for your child to be allowed into the hostel on Sunday, 31 May. If your account has not been paid, your child will not be allowed into the hostel. No downpayments will be allowed.

2.2.4 BURSARY

Please note that bursary applications already closed. No late applications will be accepted.

2.3 LOCKS

Please make sure your child has 2 locks. It remains every child's responsibility to lock his/her cupboard and room.

2.4 SCHOOL UNIFORM

We request parents to please help and make sure your child returns after a weekend with the correct school uniform. Many children give an excuse that the school shoes and clothes were forgotten at home; then they walk around all week with the wrong clothes. Thank you for your support.

2.5 ARRIVAL AT HOSTEL ON SUNDAYS

No learners will be allowed back on Sunday evenings after 19h00. Dinner on Sundays is served at 17h00. If learners arrive after 17h00, no dinner will be available for them.

2.6 SICK LEARNERS

It is happening more often that sick children arrive at the hostel on a Sunday and Monday. **Please under no circumstances should your child be sent to the hostel on a Sunday if he/she is ill. We will expect you to come and fetch your sick child.**

2.7 MEDICATION

Learners are not allowed to keep their prescribed or any other medicine in their cupboards. It must be handed in at the sick bay. Please make sure that the dosage and frequency is clearly indicated on each container. Also indicate what the medication is prescribed for. Thank you for your co-operation.

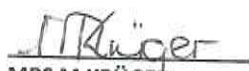
